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PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENTS

Proposed Policy on Application of Value-based Payment Modifier to ACOs beginning in CY 2017

As noted in last week's Spotlight newsletter, CMS issued a proposed rule on changes to the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (PFS) for calendar year (CY) 2015. In addition to the ACO quality proposals, this rule also contains proposed changes to the Value-based Payment Modifier (VM) including its application, beginning in CY 2017, to all groups and solo practitioners, as identified by Taxpayer Identification Numbers (TINs), including those who participate in Medicare Shared Savings Program ACOs.

The VM provides for differential payment to a physician or group of physicians under the PFS based upon the quality of care furnished compared to cost during a performance period. In CY 2015 and CY 2016, the VM will not be applied to ACO participant TINs. The proposed policies relate to the application of the VM to ACO participant TINs beginning in CY 2017:

- In general, the cost composite for ACO participant TINs that participate in the Shared Savings Program during the payment adjustment period will be classified as "average cost," and their quality composite will be based on the ACO's quality data from the performance period using a quality-tiering methodology.
- Special rules apply for ACO participant TINs leaving/joining an ACO during the payment adjustment period.

We encourage ACOs to provide feedback on the proposed policy and payment changes. CMS will accept comments on the proposed rule until 5 p.m. on September 2, 2014. In commenting, please refer to file code CMS-1612-P. You may submit comments in one of the following ways: electronically via www.regulations.gov, by regular mail, by express or overnight mail, or by hand or courier. Now Available: July Claims and Claim Line Feed Files

Based on the data request and preference files we received as of the end of June, Claim and Claims Line Feed (CCLF) files are currently available for eligible ACOs to download from your MFT mailbox. These files will be available in your MFT mailbox for 30 days.

Reminder: CAHPS Survey Vendor Selection

The administration period for the Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (CAHPS) survey of ACOs begins November 13, 2014, and ends February 2, 2015. ACOs have about 8 weeks to sign up for a CAHPS vendor for 2014 reporting. All ACOs must select a CMS approved vendor by September 22, 2014, and inform CMS of this selection.
