






- > AMP Capital was formed in 1849 as the investment branch of AMP (167 years)

- > \$20 bn property portfolio









- Absolute GHG emissions reduction (FY2009-2014)
  - 21% reduction in Office & Industrial
  - 56% reduction in Shopping Centres
  - 38% reduction across portfolio
- > That sounds good, but what's the context?

AMP Capital Property GHG emissions (t CO2e) versus growth in assets under management



- > Energy productivity (FY2009-2014)
  - 38% CO2e reduction across portfolio
  - 25% increase in value of Assets Under Management
- > Achieving decoupling of economic growth from environmental harm

- > Shifting composition of portfolio
- Ongoing energy efficiency program
  - Focused on NABERS Energy ratings
- > Renewable energy
