

Carter Phipps

Phipps is the author of the recent book *Evolutionaries—Unlocking the Spiritual and Cultural Potential of Science's Greatest Ideas*. He was, for 10 years, the executive editor of *EnlightenNext* magazine.

Carter is a leading voice in the emerging “evolutionary worldview” which combines the insights of integral philosophy, evolutionary science, developmental psychology, the social sciences, and evolutionary spirituality.

He is the Co-Founder of the Institute for Cultural Evolution, a non-profit social policy institute whose mission is to bring new insights on the evolution of culture to the arena of politics and social policy.

Sue Wilson, CSJ

Sue Wilson is Director of the Office for Systemic Justice for the Canadian Federation of the Sisters of St. Joseph where she is involved in research, advocacy, education and activism on a variety of justice issues.

Sue has a Ph.D. in moral theology with a focus on social ethics. Particular areas of interest include the dynamics of personal and social transformation, as well as the integration of contemplation and justice.
