WALKING TOUR







In this 3 hour walking tour we will show you a small portion of all Buenos Aires can offer: its neighbourhoods and history. Once you are familiar with these areas you will be able to access hundreds of interesting places and fun activities on your own, without any help.

The Plaza de Mayo (Spanish: May Square) is the main historical square in downtown Buenos Aires, Argentina; it is flanked by Hipolito Yrigoyen, Balcarce, Rivadavia and Bolivar streets.

The Buenos Aires financial district (microcentro), affectionately known as 'la City' also lies beside the Plaza. Buenos Aires (English: Fair Winds, originally 'Ciudad de la Santisima Trinidad y Puerto de Santa Maria de los Buenos Aires' (City of the Holy Trinity and Port of Saint Mary of the Fair Winds) is the capital of Argentina and its largest city and port.

The Casa Rosada (Pink House), officially known as the Palacio de Gobierno (Government Palace), is the official residence of the President of Argentina. The Plaza de Mayo has always been the focal point of political life in Buenos Aires.

Next we continue our walk, visiting some of the most ancient buildings still standing in Buenos Aires. Later, we walk towards the famous (and very old) San Telmo neighborhood. As we continue southward, we learn about early architecture in the colonies and its evolution, and start visiting the many wonders San Telmo has to offer: fascinating houses, antique stores, the old indoors market, the outdoors one (Plaza Dorrego) where Independence was sworn, and the church that gave origin to the neighborhood's name.

TANGO DINNER SHOW







Since 1867 this big old house has been established in the historic center of the City. In 1920 it was founded as a bar and then, in 1992, restored. It has a capacity for two hundred people, seated in individual tables. Its wreathed columns, boisserie and deep shaped wood, create a romantic and intimate atmosphere. Recoleta Cemetery Tour



Recoleta is a central and residential neighborhood of Buenos Aires; it is a historic and architectonic zone. The Recoleta Cemetery, which opened in 1822, is one of the main tourist attractions of the district. It is located next to the former convent of the Recollects. It is an extraordinary example of the funerary architecture of the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, with family vaults and vaults of the old bourgeoisie. It contains the remains of many players in Argentina's history, including Eva Peron whose tomb is peregrinated daily by tourists, residents and activists from all streams of Peronism. The illustrious Ovid Rebaudi, a chemist, writer, researcher, teacher, scientist, and multifaceted character of Buenos Aires culture is also buried here. There are also the tombs of the presidents of the nation: Nicolás Avellaneda, Bartolomé Mitre, Manuel Quintana, Domingo Faustino Sarmiento, Carlos Pellegrini, Hipólito Yrigoyen, Arturo Umberto Illiay Raul Alfonsin and the dictator Pedro Eugenio Aramburu. Today the cemetery contains the most densely placed sculptures in the world. This is a 3 hour tour.
