

**Tom van Teunenbroek**, *Ministry of Infrastructure and Environment, The Netherlands*, “Nanosafety Research and Legislation in European Union: Future Activities”

Tom van Teunenbroek is the coordinator of nanoReg (FP7) and the Head of CoR EU-US on regulatory aspects of nano materials. He is the advisor to the minister regarding Environment & Health and Nanosafety issues. He advises knowledge institutes like the Health Council or the RIVM on Environment & Health and on Nano-safety issues (sponsorprogramma OECD activities).

In 2010, van Teunenbroek was the Dutch negotiator for the ministerial WHO Environment and Health declaration.

He drafts the annual ministerial Environment & Health research programme.

van Teunenbroek is the Dutch delegate in the OECD WPMN = nanotechnologies Member of WPMN taskforce under SG3 on the guidance documentation on nanosafety research and is a member of the EU (DG Sanco) Indoor Air Quality expert group (particle toxicology).

He is the CO-Founder of the ERA-NET Environment and Health which includes 17 EU member states. He has led EU expert missions on EU-WFD implementation in Romania, Bulgaria, Cyprus and Croatia and several EU expert missions on EU-IPPC (heavy industry) legislation and governmental oversight implementations (in Cyprus, Romania, Bulgaria, Slovenia, Slovakia, Tjech Republic).

van Teunenbroek’s specialties include Neuro-toxicologist on the effects of etiological factors (predominantly metals) affecting signal transduction and higher functions.
