Donald R. Leavens, the National Electrical Manufacturers Association's Vice President and Chief Economist, holds a Ph.D. in economics from George Mason University. He also received a master's degree in economics from Virginia Tech and a bachelor's degree in economics from the University of Virginia.

At NEMA, he heads an in house consulting operation known as NEMA Business Information Services, which provides econometric modeling, macroeconomic forecasting, market research, economic analysis, and industry data collection services to a wide range of businesses including many of the world's largest companies.
