

NETWORK CENTRIC OPERATIONS INDUSTRY CONSORTIUM (NCOIC™)

...to bring NATO into a single enterprise ICT structure

The purpose of this Agreement between the NCI AGENCY and Network Centric Operations Industry Consortium (NCOIC™) is to outline the roles, responsibilities, contributions and system engineering and architecture support to be performed in taking a holistic view, with the aim of bringing all NATO into a single enterprise Information and Communications Technology (ICT) structure.

There is believed to be considerable savings possible if the situation can be consolidated and rationalized, and a degree of homogeneity brought to the infrastructure and application spaces, as well as to the service management and control domain.


SCOPE Assessment & Problem Definition






NCOIC was asked to consider "how to ..."

- ...facilitate backward compatibility


The Use Case...

 - * products have to fit the mission, not the other way around...


NCOIC Process Model working with NGA




...resulting in a demo, how NATO would use NGA data in a Cloud...


