1-2 September 2015, Cambridge, UK



Travel recommendations to The University Centre, Cambridge

We recommend to fly into London Stansted which is the closest airport to Cambridge (if the route exists from your location and timing permits). If not, London Heathrow and London City are the next options after Stansted. Grouped transfers back to those airports will be organised after the event. The earlier you communicate your travel details (via registration) the better we can coach you and potentially even “group” you with others arriving at the same time/airport.

From Stansted Airport to The University Centre

By train:

Catch the train from Stansted Airport to Cambridge railway station. The trains run every 30 minutes and will take 30 minutes to get to Cambridge at a cost of approximately £12.70.

From Cambridge railway station, take a taxi to University Centre. The journey will take approximately 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic, at a cost of £7-£13.

By taxi:

You can take a taxi directly from Stansted Airport to The University Centre. The journey takes approximately 40 minutes, depending on traffic, at a cost of £61 one way with luggage using a pre-booked service.

By bus:

You can pick up a National Express bus from Stansted airport to Cambridge City Centre. The bus is located on terminal road by the easy bus and taxi rank. The journey takes approximately 1 hour, depending on traffic, every 2 hours and costs approximately £8 one way. From Cambridge City Centre, take a taxi to The University Centre. The journey will take approximately 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic, at a cost of £7-£13.

From Heathrow Airport to The University Centre

By train:

Catch the train from Heathrow Airport to Cambridge railway station. Trains depart every 20 minutes and take approximately 2 hours to get to Cambridge with two changes at Paddington and then London Kings Cross station. The cost will be approximately £47.50.

From Cambridge railway station, take a taxi to The University Centre. The journey will take approximately 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic, at a cost of £7-£13.

By taxi:

You can take a taxi directly from Heathrow Airport to Corpus Christ College. The journey will take 1.5 - 2 hours, depending on traffic, at a cost of £84 - £100 one way with luggage using a pre booked service. A non-booked taxi will cost considerably more.

By bus:

You can pick up a National Express bus from Heathrow airport to Cambridge City Centre. The bus for terminal 1, 2 and 3 is located at the Central Bus Station. The bus from terminal 4 and 5 is located directly in front of the terminal, round the one way system down Salisbury Road. The journey takes approximately 3 hours, depending on traffic, every 2.5-3 hours and costs approximately £15-£18 one way. From Cambridge City Centre, take a taxi to The University Centre. The journey will take approximately 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic, at a cost of £7-£13.

From London City Airport to The University Centre

By train:

Catch the train from London City Airport to Cambridge railway station. Trains depart every half-hour and take roughly 1.5 hours to get to Cambridge with one to two changes at London Kings Cross station or Moorgate and Finsbury Park. The cost will be approximately £26.30.

From Cambridge railway station, take a taxi to The University Centre. The journey will take approximately 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic, at a cost of £7-£13.

By taxi:

You can take a taxi directly from London City Airport to The University Centre. The journey will take 1- 2 hours, depending on traffic, at a cost of £90 one way with luggage using a pre booked service. A non-booked taxi will cost considerably more.

By bus:

You can pick up a National Express bus from London City airport to Cambridge City Centre. The bus is located outside the airport by the car hire. The journey takes approximately 2.5 hours, depending on traffic, at a cost of £15 one way. From Cambridge City Centre, take a taxi to The University Centre. The journey will take approximately 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic, at a cost of £7-£13.

Parking

Park Street car park: 10-minute walk from The University Centre. Park Street car park charges £2.10 per hour. Parking for 5 hours or more requires a payment of between £17 and £24.

Grande Arcade car park: 5-minute walk from The University Centre. Grande Arcade car park charges £2.30 per hour. Parking for 5 hours or more requires a payment of between £19.50 and £25.

Lunch

If you arrive in Cambridge early and would like to have a bite to eat before the Summit begins there are several restaurants or pubs you can visit. A few, within 5 minutes walking distance from The University Centre, are listed below. Visit us at The University Centre between 12:00 and 13:00 to receive a voucher for up to £12 to purchase a light lunch at the University Centre Canteen or at a nearby pub.
