

THIS IS A HANDS-ON WORKSHOP ON THE DIGITAL WORKFLOW FOR COMPUTER-GUIDED IMPLANT PLACEMENT AND RESTORATION IN TODAY'S GENERAL PRACTICE.

Our focus is on users who wish to implement guided surgery into their practice. We will detail the specifics of data acquisition, record taking and secure electronic submission of information through multiple live 3D planning sessions. Design and manufacture of the resulting guide will allow participants to place their own implants using the actual surgical tooling and following the streamlined placement protocols. The workflow of the restorative intra-oral scans using digital scan bodies will take us to the completion of each case scenario.
