

Knitted Stars

Knitted stars in 3 sizes worked in the round as medallions to the points.

STITCH GLOSSARY

k2tog

Knit 2 together.

kfb

Knit into the front and back of next st to inc 1 st. $\mathbf{M1R}$

Insert LH needle from back to front under the strand between last st worked and next st on LH needle.

K into the front loop to twist the st.

Insert LH needle from front to back under the strand between last st worked and next st on LH needle. K into the back loop to twist the st.

SKP

M₁L

Slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over—1 stitch has been decreased.

NOTE

Instructions are written for small star with changes for medium and large star in parentheses. The small star is not stuffed.

STAR

Cast on 5 sts. Do not join.

Next row [Kfb] 5 times—10 sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd and join, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1 Knit.

Rnd 2 [K1, place marker (pm), M1R, k1, M1L, pm] 5 times around—20 sts.

Rnds 3 and 4 Knit, slipping markers.

Next (inc) rnd [K1, sl marker, M1R, k to marker, M1L, sl marker] 5 times around—10 sts inc'd.

For (medium and large) stars only

Rep inc rnd every 3rd rnd (1, 3) times more.

Points

(**Note** each point is worked back and forth in rows over the first 6 (8, 12) sts only, keeping the rem sts on hold. When each point is complete, the next is worked over the next group of sts in the same manner.)

Next (dec) row (RS) SKP, k to 2 sts before the next marker, k2tog, turn—2 sts dec'd.

Work 3 rows in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

Rep the last 4 rows 0 (2, 4) times more—4 sts rem for point.

Next (dec) row (RS) SKP, k2tog, sl first st over 2nd st and fasten off.

FINISHING

For medium and large stars only. Make a 2nd star same as first. Weave in ends. Sew the 2 stars together around the edges leaving a small opening. Stuff as desired. Sew closed. •

MATERIALS

- Small amounts of Simplicity by HiKoo/Skacel Collection, 1¾oz/50g hanks, each approx 117yd/107m (superwash wool/acrylic/nylon)
- One set (4) size 6 (4mm) double-pointed needles (dpn) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Stitch markers

For Medium and Large stars only

· Small amount of polyester stuffing

SIZES

Sized for Small, Medium, Large.

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

From point to point 2 (4, 7)"/5 (10, 18)cm

GAUGE

20 sts and 36 rnds/rows = 4"/10cm over St st using size 6 (4mm) needles.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.
