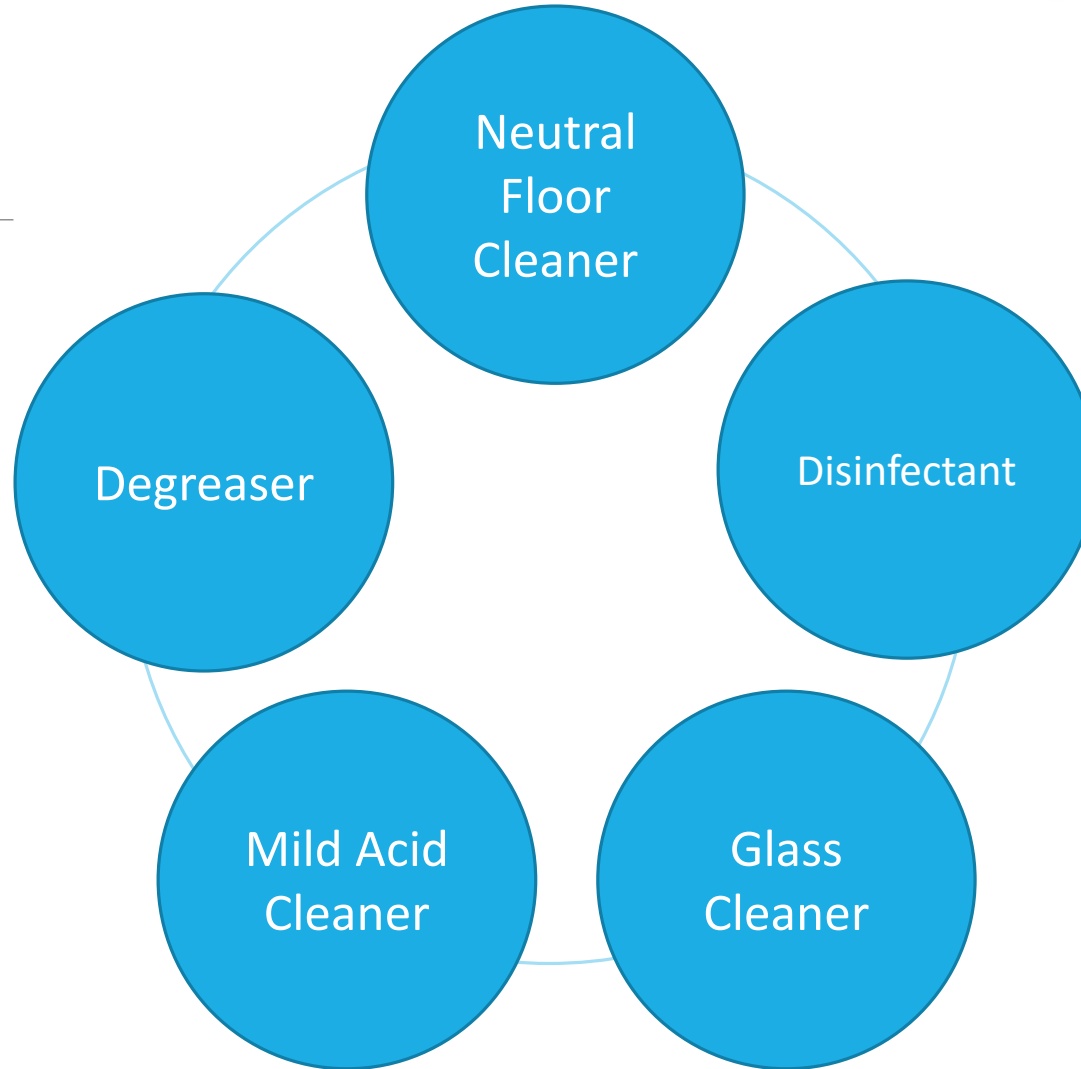


Simplifying your Daily Cleaning Process with Five Chemicals

Five Products



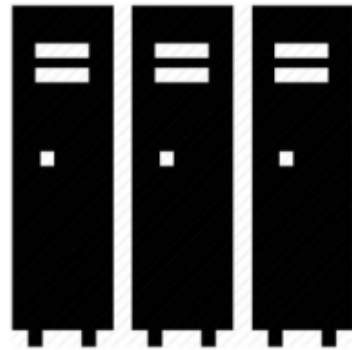
Neutral Floor Cleaner

- Typically we spend 60% of our time cleaning the floor area.
- Alberta climate can make it difficult to maintain floors
- Neutral floor cleaner can be used effectively, with the exception of washrooms, locker rooms, and pool decks
- This product can be used in either a damp mop application or through an auto scrubber



Disinfectant Cleaner

- Areas of high concern



- Ideal to use the same disinfectant for wiping and high contact areas (door handles, towel dispensers, exterior of toilets/urinals)
- Can also be used to clean floors in washrooms and locker rooms

Glass Cleaner

- Clean, translucent glass will leave a good first impression for guests who enter your building



- Dirty, fingerprinted glass will subconsciously tell your customer that the washroom and locker rooms are not clean
- First impressions do count

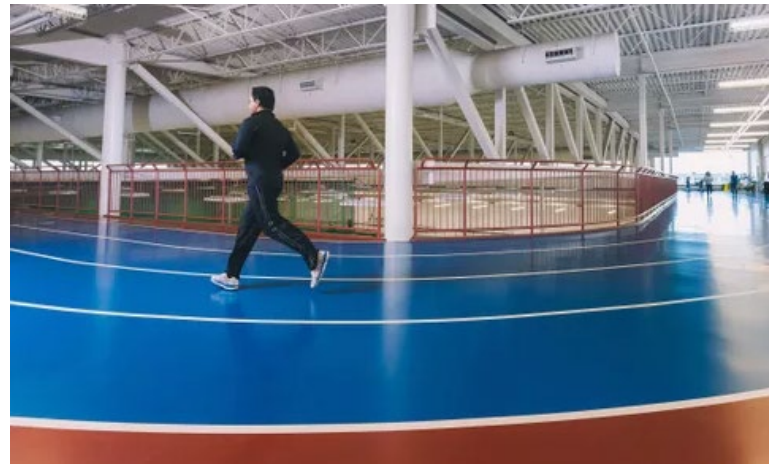
Mild Acid Cleaner/Descaler

- Running water will tend to create a build up of inorganic material such as, iron, calcium etc.
- Mild acid is used to clean inside of fixtures. Ex. Urinals
- Mild acid cleaner can also be used on a monthly basis for maintaining shower room walls and floors



Degreaser/Deep Cleaner

- Deep cleaner is used to clean greasy deposits that are left overtime Ex. Shower room
- Body oils and soap scum typically build up on the tiles after a week in the shower area
- Recommend the D-Limonene based cleaner, which is a natural solvent
- For surfaces that require more alkalinity, a well diluted degreaser/cleaner would work best



Product	Surfaces to be Cleaned
Neutral Floor Cleaner	Resilient Floors, concrete, running tracks, arena seating, arena floors.
Disinfectant	Washrooms, Locker rooms, shower and pool decks. High contact touch surfaces in washrooms and throughout the building.
Glass Cleaner	Glass, mirrors, chrome.
Mild Acid Descaler	Shower walls, urinals, anywhere hard water deposits form.
Mild Based Citrus Degreaser	Shower rooms, deep scrubbing, weight room floors, running tracks.

Conclusion

- Training safety and ease-of-use in the commercial cleaning industry is the foundation of any cleaning program
- Creating a training program on how to effectively use these 5 products will ensure cleaning procedures will be completed in a timely and effective manner
